## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

1. Cannock & District Car Club will promote a Clubsport Production car Autotest on 7<sup>th</sup> March at Curborough Sprint Circuit, Lichfield Staffs.
2. The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of the MSA Motor Sports Association Limited, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA) these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. The MSA permit number: TBC
4. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, Owen MC, Streetly MC & Wolverhampton SSCC. Club membership cards will be inspected at signing on.
5. The programme of the meeting will be:  
Scrutineering starts at 08.30  
Any competitor not signed on by 09:30 maybe excluded.  
Driver's briefing 09:45  
First car starts at 10.00
6. The event will consist of 5 classes as follows:  
A. Standard front wheel drive cars, up to 1400cc or Battery or hybrid powered  
B. Standard front wheel drive cars 1401 up, also Battery powered hybrid  
C. Modified front wheel drive cars, e.g. not stand & road rally, Autotest cars  
D. Standard front engined, rear wheel drive cars also Battery power or hybrid  
E. Turbo Powered cars, 4 wheel drive Cars, rear Engined Cars (all Stage Rally Cars) (Sprint cars), & all cars fitted with torque biasing differentials & Modified rear wheel drive cars  
All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations.
7. Awards will be presented as follows:  
Best juniors in The `March Hare` PCA, aged from 14 to 16  
Fastest time of the day  
First in each class  
Second in each class, subject to 5 entries in the class  
Best lady, an Award  
Best novice (a competitor who has not previously won any award on any Autotest)
8. The entry list opens on publication of these SR's & closes at 17.00 on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2010. The entry fee is £20. All entries must be on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.
9. The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 40; the minimum is 15. The minimum for each class is 1. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Starting order will be determined by ballot. Entry fees may be refunded at the organisers discretion.

12. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.

13. Marking and penalties will be as printed below & not as in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations.

Pylons, + 10 seconds for each pylon hit.

Lines, + 10 seconds for not stopping astride a line

Wrong test = Fasters competitors time for that test/ class + 30 seconds

All 4 wheels on the grass will be classed as a wrong test

14. Details of the tests will be notified at signing on.

Each driver will have 3 runs, at each test to count for awards.

Timing will be by hand-held digital stopwatch.

The starting signal will be 'in your own time'

Order of attempting tests will be at organisers discretion.

Practising will not be allowed.

15. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are modified. (Amendments maybe posted for 2010 blue book)

Penalties see rule 13 Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.

D, 41. Light commercial & Battery powered are permitted.

16 Things you must Note.

(D) 35 One passenger must be carried in each car and must be 14 years or older

(D) 43 All open top cars must have the HOODS ERECTED (or hard tops) fitted

Vehicles must have a VALID MOT AND BE TAXED for road,

YOU MUST HAVE YOUR MOT PAPERS WITH YOU.

(C) Chart 24, Maximum Noise Limits is 100db @ 0.5m or 88db @ 2.0m

\*\* Most standard cars are usually well under, this is aimed at modified cars \*\*

We will need your Club Card on the day, so bring it with you. Vehicles must have a valid MOT & be taxed for the road, YOU MUST HAVE YOUR MOT PAPERS WITH YOU. You will need a passenger in your car, your passenger must be 14 or older they can help read the test maps to you on the event, if your passenger is 14 to 18 years old their guardian must SIGN for them on the day (see form) All open top cars must have the hoods erected (or hard tops fitted). If you are a 14 to 18 years old driver & do not have a full UK driving licence, your passenger must have a full UK driving licence (bring it along) also if you are 14 to 18 years old your guardian must SIGN for you on the day (see form above)

### Things you must do before you arrive

Take out all loose things in your car, nothing must be rolling around. Check the battery is secure along with brake fluid levels, coolant levels & tyre pressures and that your seat and belts are in good condition. Get to the venue in plenty of time.

### When you arrive on the event

Take your car to be scrutinised & the 'noise' test first. The 'Noise' test is mainly for none standard exhausts. Then take you pass card to Sign on. Both you & your passenger must sign on, Please NO later than 9.30am (you will need your club card) If you are the driver & you are 14 to 18 years old or do not have a full UK driving licence, your passenger must have their full UK driving licence with them. Also if you are 14 to 18 years old your guardian must sign for you on the day (see form). Take a walk around the tests, taking the exact route `IT WILL HELP`. Make the time to go to the drivers & passengers briefing (safety). Always have your seat belts on when competing do not put your arms outside the car when moving on the tests. Never clown around (we will exclude you) do not exceed 10 MPH between tests. Finally have a good event, have fun but KEEP SAFETY IN MIND at all times.
