



## SMC Drive It Day 2024 Supplementary Regulations

### 1. Announcement

Streetly Motor Club are pleased to invite members (including those of affiliated AWMMC clubs) to participate in their charity Drive It Day on Sunday 22nd September 2024. The event will run under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK as applicable to a Touring Assembly. A certificate of exemption will be obtained from Motorsport UK and displayed at the start of the event, during signing-on.

The event is designed to be a social and motoring event enabling you to meet like-minded individuals and enjoy a day out in your pride and joy; it is *not* a competitive event.

### 2. Eligible Vehicles

The event is open to all types of road-going cars (or van derivatives). It takes place on public roads therefore all cars must have appropriate insurance, road tax and MOT (as applicable).

### 3. Entry Details

Entries open from the time of publication of these regulations, and close on Friday 13th September at 6pm.

<b>Entrant Type</b>	<b>Entry Fee</b>
Paid-up member of Streetly MC	£25
Paid-up member of any AWMMC-affiliated club <sup>1</sup>	£25
All other entrants	£35

The entry fee covers the entrant and all passengers within one vehicle (including navigator) up to a maximum of 4 people. Vehicles with more than 4 persons are not allowed without prior agreement from the entries secretary.

£10 of each entry will be donated to St. Giles Hospice

The maximum number of entries for the event is 20 vehicles. The minimum number of entries is 8. If the minimum number of entries is not made, Streetly MC reserves the right to cancel the event. In such an eventuality, all entry fees will be refunded in full.

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<sup>1</sup> entrants will be required to evidence their membership on the day

Entries may be withdrawn up until 9pm, Saturday 14th September for a full refund. In order to cover costs, Streetly MC reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fee for any withdrawals made **after** this point in time.

Withdrawals must be made to the entries secretary by email.

#### 4. Route Details

The event will start from **Gilks Garage Cafe**, near Kineton, Warwickshire CV35 0JZ. Entrants to arrive for 9.00am. First car to depart approximately 9.30am. The cafe has kindly offered a 10% voucher for a breakfast bap and hot drink per crew member.

The suggested route runs primarily through Warwickshire - initially west, before turning north and eventually finishing at our exclusive Hunting Lodge at **Merevale Estate** near Atherstone (CV9 2HF).

The route is approximately 80 miles. Route instructions will be provided. There will be opportunities for comfort breaks and petrol stations along the route. A mid-route stop is not pre-arranged, although the route will make recommendations of suitable locations where you can stop for refreshments.

There will be a small number of fun clues and “*spot the...*” style questions along the way to keep you entertained!

Anticipated arrival at the finish venue will be from 2.30pm onwards (allowing for stops en-route) but the event is not a race and there is no need to aim for a time! Finish time at the venue will be 5pm.

Entry includes free hot dogs, snacks, hot and soft drinks at the finish for all the vehicle occupants. Dogs are welcome but must be kept under control.

Final instructions will be issued to entrants via email on Sunday 15th September
